WHEREAS: In the last several years, 126 commemorative events have been hosted in

Minnesota to honor 88, 713 recognized Vietnam veterans, who served on

active duty between November 1, 1955 and May 15, 1975; and

WHEREAS: These Vietnam veterans earned the right to be publicly acknowledged for

their sacrifice and service to our nation; and

WHEREAS: The VA estimates we are losing 541 of these heroes every day, and the time

to thank them is running out; and

WHEREAS: It is never too late to pay tribute to and honor those who answered our

nation's call in Vietnam; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota joins the national movement to recognize all Vietnam War

Veterans on March 29, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, March 29, 2020, as:

MINNESOTA VIETNAM VETERANS DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
