Let me encourage you ... 2020 is not the year to relax in our efforts to thank these deserving men and women! You are getting a "sneak peek" at our 2020 *March* 29 poster (at left); it is my hope you will *re-double* your efforts on and around that day to bring as many Vietnam veterans as possible into your respective "public squares" to be honored by friends and neighbors. 2.5 million reached is admirable, but another 3.7 million remain who have not yet been publicly and individually thanked on behalf of the Nation! In addition, the Department of Veterans Affairs estimates we will *lose* 559 Vietnam veterans *daily* in 2020. Clearly, our

time is limited to reach them all, so I urge each of you to continue this most honorable pursuit!
