The country is talking about *National Vietnam War Veterans Day!*Nearly 60 thousand Vietnam veterans and their families were safely thanked and honored – in person – during 565 events, on and around 29 March, thanks to your dedicated efforts! In addition, media coverage with a potential reach to 319 million, along with nearly 35 thousand social media engagements and 241 thousand views of vietnamwar50th.com were record-breaking numbers – a 40-time increase in reach and impact from just one year ago!
