Dear Commemorative Partners,

This month, we commemorate two significant days, *National Medal of Honor Day*—March 25, and <u>National Vietnam War Veterans Day</u> (NVWVD)—March 29.

In recognition of *National Medal of Honor Day*, we look to our Nation's <u>Medal of Honor history</u>, which began during the Civil War period. To date, more than 3,500 U.S. service members have been awarded our country's highest military distinction for valor. Of those, 268 are from the Vietnam War and 48 remain alive today.

President Biden presented Vietnam veteran, retired <u>U.S. Army Colonel Paris D. Davis</u> this award on March 3 at The White House for his gallant actions rescuing his wounded troops following an attack on June 18, 1965. Three days after The White House presentation, Davis was <u>inducted</u> into the Hall of Heroes at the Pentagon by Deputy Secretary of Defense Kathleen H. Hicks.
