WHEREAS, their legacy of patriotism and dedication to our country is an inspiration to all Americans; and

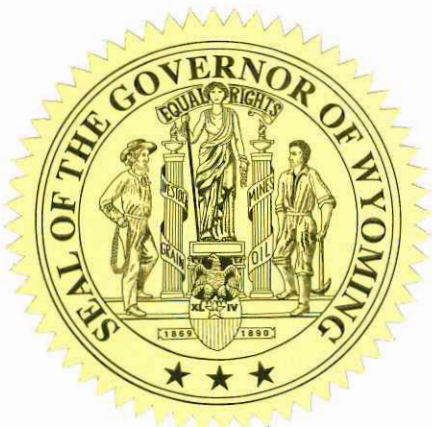
