*Whereas*, more than 58,000 men and women made the ultimate sacrifice for our country and gave their lives while serving in the Vietnam War; and

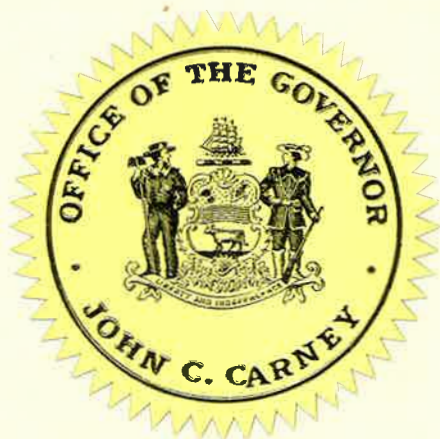
*Whereas*, Vietnam War veterans have made significant contributions to their communities since returning to their respective states, including here in Delaware; and
