



# THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA VIETNAM WAR COMMEMORATION



On behalf of the entire staff of The United States of America Vietnam War Commemoration, thank you for ordering material to thank and honor Vietnam veterans and their families, and for your continued support honoring our Nation's Vietnam veterans.

As the Commemoration moves toward completion in 2025, and in order to better unify our efforts to thank and honor our Vietnam veterans and their families, we are phasing out the Deceased Vietnam Veteran's Surviving Spouse Lapel Pin (known as the Surviving Spouse Lapel Pin or SSLP) and Certificate.

Effective immediately, the SSLP and accompanying Certificate of Honor will no longer be available for new issuance through the Commemorative Partner Portal. Any remaining inventory of these pins will be used to support ongoing Honorary Partner initiatives until the stock is depleted, and Honorary Partners should therefore continue their process as normal.

In its place, the Vietnam Veteran Lapel Pin (VVLP) will be substituted for presentation to these surviving spouses of deceased Vietnam veterans. We consider it a privilege to honor these spouses for their sacrifice with the very same distinguished memento that their Vietnam veteran would have received for their service.

In addition, the Commemoration has discontinued the following items and they are no longer available through our Partner Portal on the website.

50<sup>th</sup> (Eagle) Tin Pin  
2012 (President Obama) Proclamation  
2017 (President Trump) Proclamation
