As we enter a new month, the <u>National Guard</u> celebrates 387 years of dedicated service to our Nation on *December 13*. "Always Ready, Always There," remains their long-standing inspirational motto, guiding them daily.

More than 50 years ago, our United States Army and Air Force branches deployed National Guard units and individual

Guardsmen to Vietnam and around the world in support of combat operations. According to the Guard's <u>Remembering the Vietnam War</u>, by the end of the war, over 9,000 Guardsmen served in-country, with over 100 making the ultimate sacrifice in service of their Nation.
